SYMPTOMATIC?

Are you experiencing any of these symptoms?

- Fever of 100.4°F or Higher / Chills
- New Cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Sore Throat
- Runny Nose/ Congestion
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Loss of Taste or Smell



STAY SAFE AND ISOLATE!

- Self-schedule a test: <https://my.primary.health//gvh>; OR
- Call COVIDCheck Colorado (720) 419-1087
- Isolate until you receive a negative test result; OR
- If your result is POSITIVE, your isolation ends 10 days after symptoms began AND will include being fever free for 24 hours AND symptoms improving before ending isolation.
- Public Health will contact you to determine the time frame of your isolation and if you have exposed anyone else.
- Stay at home, except for medical care.

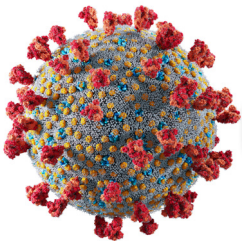
Symptomatic/Non- Symptomatic

Not Vaccinated:

Vaccinated:

If you are exposed to COVID-19 and have no symptoms:	Get tested 5-7 days after your last exposure and quarantine for 10-14 days.	Get tested 5-7 days after last exposure and monitor carefully for symptoms. Wear a mask in public for 14 days. Quarantine not required if you remain symptom free.
If you are exposed to COVID-19 and have ANY symptoms:	Get tested right away and isolate until you get your results. If positive, keep isolating. Return to activities on the 11th day after symptoms started. If negative, stay home for 10-14 days from your last exposure.	Get tested right away and isolate. If positive, keep isolating. Return to activities on the 11th day after symptoms started. If negative, stay home while you have symptoms. (If the test was an antigen test, confirm with a negative molecular/PCR test.)

SCREENING TEST FOR SURGERY OR OTHER REASON?



Wear a Mask, Social Distance and Wash Your Hands

- Stay at home as much as possible
- Wear your mask when you go into public and avoid gatherings
- Maintain 6 feet distance from others
- Wash your hands often
- Monitor yourself for new symptoms: Fever of 100.4°F or higher, chills, new cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, severe fatigue, sore throat, runny nose or congestion, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting, loss of taste or smell, headache
- If you develop any of these symptoms, stay home and schedule another COVID test.
- Surgery patients, please notify your surgeon of new symptoms.
