TAKENOTE:

- Rides must be scheduled a minimum of 2 hours in advance. Please be ready 15 minutes before your scheduled pick up time.
- Rides are scheduled on a first come, first served basis. No preference is given to any individual rider.
- When scheduling a round-trip, please let our dispatcher know how long you expect to be at your destination; this will allow us to plan your pick-up.
 - If you do not know how long you will be at your destination, you will need to call for a ride when you are finished.
- Medical appointments should be scheduled between 10am and 5pm to ensure there is adequate time to get you to and from your appointment. Please call as soon as you know your appointment date and time so we can better serve your needs.
- If you must cancel a ride, please call Senior Transportation (970-596-6700) as soon as possible so the daily schedule can be adjusted accordingly.

- Transportation extends up to 3 miles outside of the Gunnison City Limits.
- In the event of adverse weather or unsafe transportation conditions, we will cancel senior transportation for the day. You will be contacted if you have a scheduled trip.

OTHER**OPTIONS:** RTA BUS SERVICE:

The Gunnison Valley RTA provides deviated fixed route service in the City of Gunnison for passengers who wish to travel between the North and South ends of the Valley.

The RTA buses will deviate from the bus route within the City of Gunnison (up to 3/4 of a mile) to pick up and drop off ADA eligible passengers who are unable to physically access a bus stop in Gunnison. Requests must be received at least 24 hours in advance.
